INVENTORY



Hospitals are required to maintain an accurate inventory of all medical equipment used in their facilities.*

2
MAINTENANCE



Hospitals are required to follow medical equipment manufacturer recommendations for maintenance, or maintain a documented AEM program to minimize risk.*

3
SAFETY &
AVAILABILITY



All medical equipment must be performance tested for safety and availability.*
