We are committed to employee, patient, and user safety as well as pollution prevention. As an organization we continue to promote the sustainable use of resources, to reduce health and safety risks, and to reduce the environmental effects of our products.

In support of these initiatives, Ohio Medical LLC has established procedures and processes to routinely contact our suppliers and ensure compliance with the following regulations/requirements:

Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH): Ohio Medical LLC identifies and manages risks linked to certain substances of very high concern (SVHC) present in products manufactured and marketed in the European Union (EU).

Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS): Ohio Medical LLC continuously works with suppliers to ensure compliance to European Directive 2011/65/EU as amended by (EU) 2015/863.

Proposition 65 (State of California): The state of California enacted Proposition 65, officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986. Ohio Medical LLC maintains compliance and adhere to providing potential warnings to the state of California regarding significant exposure to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm.

Conflict Minerals (Dodd-Frank Act): The Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) requires companies to provide information pertaining to Conflict Minerals under the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.
